NEW MASS SCHEDULE

As of June 19, 2018, Rev. James J. Ward will be Pastor of both Immaculate Conception Church & St. Joseph Church. Beginning Wed., June 20, the Mass schedule will be as follows:

Weekday Mass will be held at 8:00 a.m.

Mon., Wed. & Fri. at St. Joseph Church
Tues. & Thurs. at ICC

Weekend Masses:

Sat. Vigil: 4:30 p.m. at ICC
6:30 p.m. at St. Joseph Church

Sunday: 8:00 a.m. at St. Joseph Church
10:30 a.m. at ICC

The Mass schedule for both Parishes will be published in both bulletins each week. Parishioners of both parishes can attend any Mass at either Parish, and envelopes can be placed in either Church's collection basket and will be credited to the corresponding Parish of registration. The Diocese has given permission for one Mass Intention from each Parish to be listed each day, regardless of the location of the Mass. So, there will be two (2) intentions for each weekday Mass (1 from each Parish). The Sunday Mass intentions currently scheduled at St. Joseph Parish for 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. will be combined into the 8:00 a.m. Mass time.



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Have a child entering First through Eighth grade in the public school, non-Catholic private school, or are you homeschooling?
