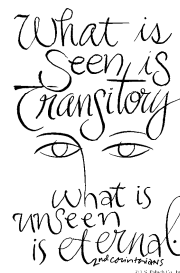

MISSION CO-OP: The Diocesan Propagation of Faith Office has invited the Diocese of Kumbakonam, India to speak about their mission activities & challenges next weekend, June 9/10. This Indian Diocese has an area of 7823sq km and a Catholic population of 213,000 (6% of total population). The Diocese has meaningful goals for a new evangelization, such as: establishing 10 more parishes. (Currently 93); providing catholic schools with better facilities, Bibles, text-books; provide building & infrastructure to mission schools in villages; education of seminarians; & education of 1000 very poor or orphan children. 60% of the Catholics are depressingly poor. Therefore, your fervent prayers and generous help are requested.

PETER'S PENCE Next week, we will take up the Peter's Pence Collection, which provides Pope Francis with the funds he needs to carry out his charitable works around the world.
