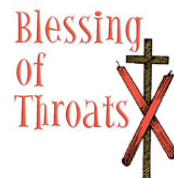

MAGISTERIUM & SACRED DEPOSIT OF FAITH: These two terms you have heard during Mass. The terms define and shape our Universal Church and Sacred Liturgy. The Magisterium of the Catholic Church is the teaching body; it interprets Scripture and upholds Tradition. It ensures what is passed down from biblical days is correctly being presented and followed as best as we can. Priests work in union with the Pope and Bishops to authentically offer to parishioners the Gospel Message and how to incorporate it in daily life. The Sacred Deposit of Faith is the actual writings in the bible (Scripture), and practices of the people (Tradition) that Christ lived and taught to the original apostles. They, in turn, handed it over to the disciples and we today, draw from this and hopefully follow, so that we may grow in holiness and ultimately reach Christ in Heaven.

The two terms are united, intimately connected and is given for us to have a **complete** life in Christ and His Church. As we move forward in our Parish, let us become keenly aware and sensitive to what is being offered and not just listen but be active on what we hear. The Gospel writer John said in his letter, "What was from the beginning, what we have heard, what we have seen with our eyes, and what we have touched with our hands; we now proclaim to you so that our joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." [1 John 1:1-4]
